What's the difference between a physical workbook and the Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials?

Physical Workbook vs. Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials

Mainly, the content is the same from the physical workbook to the Signing Naturally

Interactive Online Student Materials.

There was minor editing in a few instances, so they would not be exactly the same. Also, some instructions were changed to reflect online interactive activities. When we made "long form" questions into multiple choice, some sections of the answers were shortened, or some parts left out of the possible answer in the book.

The Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials will contain everything needed for the student to complete your course. They will not need the physical workbook. All videos/assignments are included in the Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials, adapted from the physical workbooks.

Teachers need to set up the assignments for the students in the school LMS; we will provide how-to instructions.

Within your school's LMS, grading will be automatic for assignments. The grades will sync every hour and will not show up in the gradebook immediately.

Should I require both the physical Signing Naturally Student Workbook and the Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials in one course?

You should not mix both physical student workbooks and the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials* within a single course because students with the physical student workbook will not be able to access any assignments on the school LMS, which would require you to create two different setups for students.

If you would like to review the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials* yourself, inform your onboarding contact person that you would like to access our Canvas "sandbox."

You will receive a link to join a "course" as a "student." Take your time and review as many homework assignments as you like!

If you'd rather have access and hands-on experience, we will need to establish a handshake/connection with your school. We would need your IT/LMS specialist information to complete that step. After connection, you would be able to add the materials to a course and see how it works within your school LMS. We will provide How-To instruction guides for you.

There is no cost to your school or yourself as a teacher for this LTI integration to occur.

Do we have to do this entire procedure with IT again when we are ready to use Units 7-12?

No, it will be automatically included in the existing DawnSignDigital connection you have with us. Using the same process for Units 1-6, you can find Units 7-12 in the directory when selecting assignments.

You do not need the online video library because all the necessary student materials are available in the course that you set up with the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials*.

We do provide free access to the online video library for teachers upon request if you would like to continue using it.

The complete student materials, including the video library, is available inside the Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials; the online video library is only for access to the student videos and is meant to be used only with the physical workbook.

Can I add multiple homework assignments at the same time instead of adding individual homework assignments one by one?

Can I add multiple homework assignments at the same time?

As of right now, LTI 1.3 only allows us to add assignments one at a time.

Do I have to add assignments all over again for every course I teach?

Assignments can be copied over from previous courses. We do advise setting up a shell course of some kind that you can simply copy from each time you need to set up a new course. You will need to revisit the course to update due dates accordingly.

Will DawnSignPress make changes in the future to allow students to view which questions they answered incorrectly?

Can students review incorrect answers?

Upon the completion of the integration of the DawnSignDigital LTI with your LMS, your DawnSignPress contact will provide you with "Answer Key" documents for the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials*. The documents are stored in Dropbox and are only viewable with the passwords we will provide for you. If students want to know the right answer, they need to make a note of the assignment and slide number and check with the teacher. The teacher can then refer to the documents and inform the student.

The current version of the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials* does not allow for students to see the correct answer if they get the wrong answer.

Are there questions on the homework assignments related to the reading? If so, are questions multiple choice or short answer - if short answer, how does the auto grading work?

■ How does the grading work for multiple choice or short answer?

Short answers are graded the same way as multiple-choice answers. The answer will either be correct or incorrect. Answers in the interactive materials are never long format answers that require a teacher to read and grade. At the end of a Homework, the student will receive a percentage grade based upon the total number of questions they answered correctly out of the total number of questions.

We included multiple 'right' answers for the write-in short answers that can be subjective.

Here's an example for money:

If the answer is \$5.00, a student can type in 5, 5.00, \$5 or \$5.00.

Here's an example for words:

If the answer is band-aid, a student can type in bandaid, bandaids, band-aids

I teach more than one course but as the same teacher. Can I use the same code for both courses (for example, ASL 1 and ASL 2?)

Yes, your access code will work in both courses as long as it's being used in the same LMS.

I split the Signing Naturally Units 1-6 into two classes. I teach Units 1-3 for ASL 1, and then I use Units 4-6 for ASL 2. Would my students be able to use their Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials code in a different course (after the students are done with ASL 1 and are ready to start ASL 2)?

■ Would my students be able to reuse their IOSM code if I split Units 1-6, or 7-12, into two... The student will be able to use the same code for your ASL 1 and ASL 2 classes even if Units 1-6 are split across two courses. The Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials code is good for 12 months upon redemption.

I teach at two or more colleges. Can I use the same code to access the student materials for all schools?

Can I use the same code to access the materials if I teach at multiple colleges? No, we can provide you with a code for each school for which you are using the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials*.

If you are teaching both Units 1–6 and Units 7–12, you will need a code for each set of units for each school in which you are using the *Signing Naturally Interactive Online Student Materials*. There is no cost for these codes for teachers.

I saw the teacher/student materials through an online page/PDF, but now I can't find it. Can I have that to use?

There are no Signing Naturally materials available as PDFs. If your students mention having this, it was sold illegally.

Is the Tic-Tac-Toe assignment (2.3) screen flipped? My students had a problem with that. Is it an error?

The Tic-Tac-Toe is based on the signer's perspective, not the viewer's perspective.

Why are my students' grades not showing up right?

The error is occurring because the assignments in your course are set to one attempt.

Our LTI transfers (syncs) grades with your LMS every hour. Because the assignments in your course are set to 1 attempt, the first time a grade is transferred, your LMS considers that attempt complete and locks that grade into your grade book.

Unfortunately, if a student is only midway through an assignment, whatever their grade is during a transfer will lock in as their grade.

The good news is that if you change the number of attempts to unlimited for the assignments your students have completed, the grades that are currently incorrect in your grade book will be replaced with the student's actual, final grade that they achieved on the assignments.

We are aware that students can take an assignment repeatedly until they achieve 100% but we don't see that occurring with most students using the materials. When a student gets to the end of a Homework, scores over 80%, and clicks Continue, that will become their final grade. If they click Retry, they can change their grade by answering all the questions again.
