


## Submitting a Video Assignment (Panopto)

If your instructor has assigned you to create a video as an assignment, the instructions may look like this.



**Video Submission**


- Step 1:** Prepare your video in Panopto video library. If it's not ready, click [here](#) to navigate to your personal folder in Panopto.
- Step 2:** Videos are submitted as part of assignments via clicking on "Write Submission".
- Step 3:** In the text editor expand "Mashups" and select "Panopto Student Video Submission".
- Step 4:** If your submission is not in the default personal folder select the folder where your submission is stored.
- Step 5:** Once at the folder your submission is located select the submission and click "Insert".
- Step 6:** Once your submission has been added to the text editor add any extra information and submit.

You will need to create a video and load it into Panopto in order to submit it. Follow the instructions, specifically Step 1 to access Panopto. You can click the link "here" to access your personal video folder in Panopto.

Once in Panopto, you can upload a video that you created externally, or create one using the Panopto recorder. (Instructions)

When your video has been created and you are ready to submit it, click on the title of the assignment and follow the instructions in the remainder of the steps.

Use Write Submission and choose the Mashups button to select the "Panopto Student Video Submission" option.

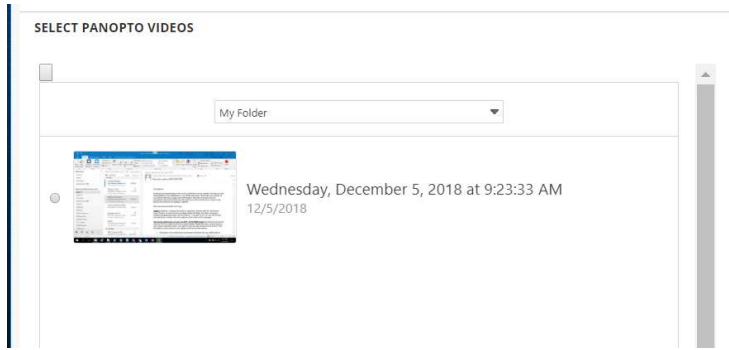


ASSIGNMENT SUBMISSION
