The Photo Course Roster is located on the Teaching tab of the Teaching application in UR Student.


## **View and Print Student Rosters**

 Log into <u>UR Student</u> and click the **Teaching** application on the home page



- On the **Teaching** tab, select **Photo Course Roster** on the right-hand side
- Enter the Academic Period (e.g., Fall 2024 AS&E) for which you
  want to generate a Photo Roster and click OK. The roster will be
  produced for each of your course sections for the academic period.



4. A report will display with a row for each of the students in your sections for the term. This is NOT the final roster. Use the Print button at the bottom left to generate a version with larger photos.



- Depending on the size of the roster, you may be asked if you want to be notified later. You can wait for the roster to appear, or you can select Notify Me Later.
- If you chose Notify Me Later, the roster will appear in your notification log, which you can access at the top right of the page. You will get a notification when it is ready. You may need to refresh the page to see it.



7. The Photo Course Roster will appear as a notification item. Just click on the hyperlink to access the roster.



## View/Print Photo Course Roster from the Teaching Tab



Depending on the number of course sections and students, you will more than likely receive a Photo Course Roster that is multiple pages. You can see the academic period and the course section at the top of each page.

The black bar at the top can be used to **view, download or print** the Photo Course Roster. You can navigate between the pages using the arrows at the top in the middle of the page. You can choose to download or print the roster using the download or printer icons at the top right of the page. You may find it more useful to print the roster and re-order the pages to fit your preference (they will appear in alphabetical order by course section (subject, course number, section number), which may cause cross listed sections with multiple course subjects to not appear on adjacent pages).
